According to the June 2020 BMO Regional Labour Market Report Card, Moncton, NB had the best overall labour market performance among Canadian cities.



N.B. was the first province to ease COVID-19 restrictions, allowing offices, barbershops, recreational facilities, etc. to open ahead of other provinces.



Greater Moncton and Southeast New Brunswick's unemployment rate has remained lower than the Canadian average throughout most of COVID-19.



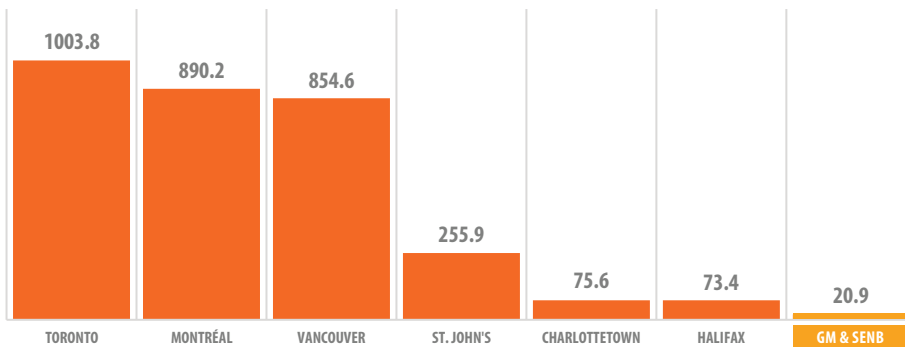

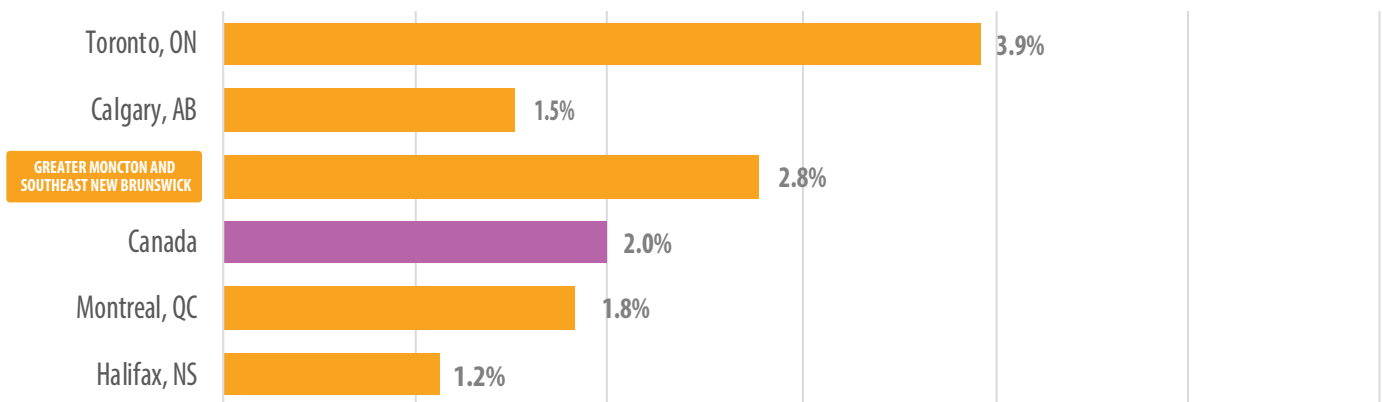
