The Greater Moncton CMA's unemployment rate has remained below the Canadian average throughout most of COVID-19.



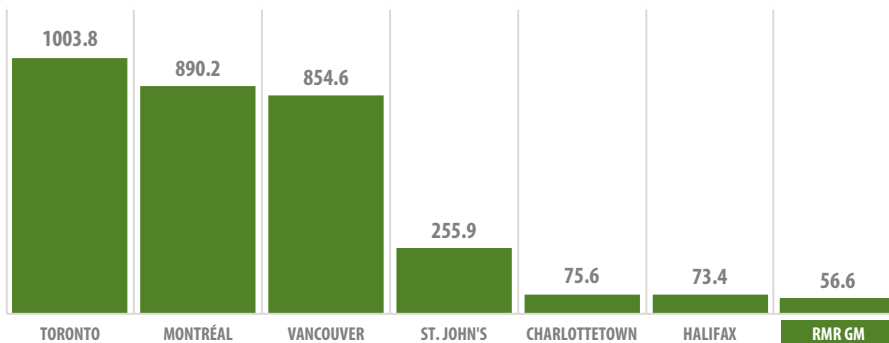

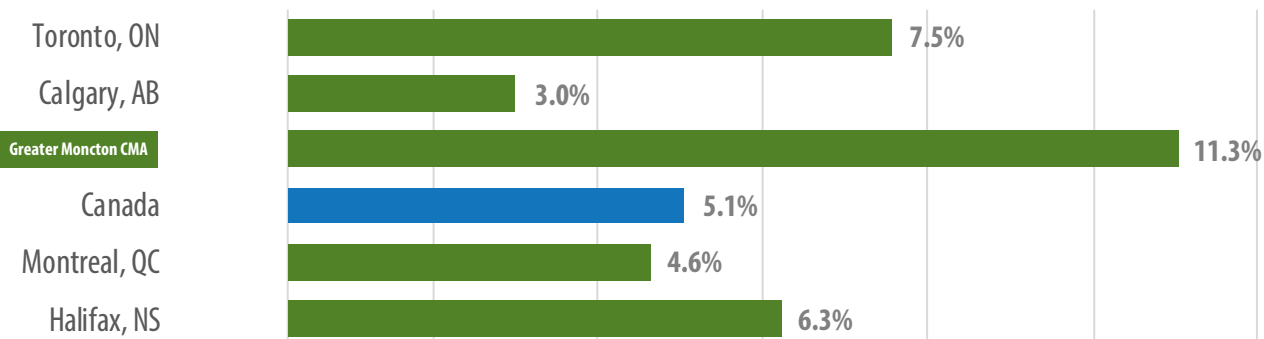
